Thank you to families for your intential effort in arriving to school by 8:45 daily! As we have returned from Winter Break, we are seeing an increase in the number of students arriving after 9am. As a reminder, arriving by 8:45 allows students to be ready for instruction which begins promptly at 9am. Celebrating and Encouraging POSITIVE Student Behavior:

CCES celebrates our mission to make an intentional effort to recognize and celebrate students when they demonstrate positive behavior. This mindset allows every adult within CCES to regularly find opportunities to celebrate and reinforce positive student behaviors. Parents are asked to join us in reinforcing this positive message by helping your child identify practical ways that they can demonstrate positive behavior throughout the school day.



Student Attendance:

There is significant evidence that students who attend school regularly benefit in many ways. Church Creek Elementary School has a goal for students to attend school 95% of the school year. This means that students should not miss more than 9 school days. Students who miss greater than 9 days are considered chronically absent. Knowing if your child is too sick for school is important, please see the 'When is my child too sick for school' flier below.


