Chromebook Protection Plan Available:

Each student within HCPS has been provided with a device to use for instructional purposes. As noted in the device agreement, parent/guardian will be responsible for all damage or loss to an HCPS owned device, whether in or out of school. HCPS is offering the option to purchase device protection. This plan will cover the cost of accidental damage to the device. The plan is available for purchase for \$20 if purchased by October 31st and \$50 if purchased between November 1 and January 31, 2023.


