Documentation of birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence are required at the time of registration. Call the doctor if...

I've been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than two days.

I've had the sniffles for more than a week, and they aren't getting better.

I still have asthma symptoms after using my asthma medicine (and call 911 if I'm having trouble breathing after using an inhaler).
