

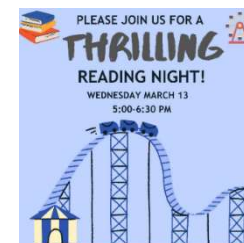


CCES Sunday Night Call – March 3, 2024

Kindergarten Registration 2024-2025:

Registration for kindergarten students attending CCES in the fall is underway! While kindergarten registration is open all summer, it benefits CCES greatly to have an accurate idea of the number of kindergarten students planned to attend in the fall.

Children must be at least 5 years of age on or before September 1 to be eligible for kindergarten. A custodial parent (biological, adoptive, legal guardian) must register your child. Documentation of birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence are required at the time of registration. Although some of the registration process can be completed online, all parents will sign up for a time to come to school to meet with Mrs. Wachter to complete the registration process.
