Children must be at least 5 years of age on or before September 1 to be eligible for kindergarten. A custodial parent (biological, adoptive, legal guardian) must register your child. Documentation of birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence are required at the time of registration. 

Participants will identify strategies to support their child's May 8th 6:00-8:00 p.m.


