#### Solar Eclipse:

Tomorrow afternoon the Maryland region will experience a near total eclipse of the sun. A solar eclipse occurs when the moon comes directly between the sun and earth. Students will have an opportunity to step outside tomorrow afternoon around 3pm to view the eclipse. In order for your child to participate, a parent permission slip must be submitted. Students will be provided with appropriate solar eclipse glasses to protect their eyes and teachers will express the importance of keeping the glasses on when

looking at the sky. Students will also view a short video of a solar eclipse prior to going outside. Families can support our efforts by expressing to children the importance of never looking at the sun without proper eye protection.
